

ENGINEER OF THE YEAR IN GOVERNMENT.. Nancy M. Redgate, P.E.

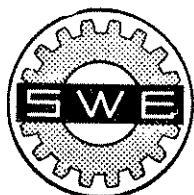
Nancy Redgate is an environmental engineer with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency where she is responsible for the management of water quality projects planned by local governments in Tennessee and Florida. Prior to this she was Chief of the Sub-division Section in the New Castle County Delaware Engineering Department. In this capacity Nancy and her staff worked to develop and enforce regulations for new developments to overcome problems the county was having with sewer systems, storm water drainage, flood plain management, erosion, and sediment.

Nancy received her Bachelor of Civil Engineering from the University of Delaware and will receive a Master's of Public Administration from Georgia State University this March. She is a registered professional engineer in Georgia and three other states.

Nancy and her husband Bill, also a professional engineer, have two grown children.

Nancy is a past president of the Philadelphia Section of the Society of Women Engineers and has served on several national level committees. She also was the treasurer of the Delaware Society of Civil Engineers. Nancy is currently the treasurer of the Sandy Springs Chapter of G.S.P.E. and treasurer for the Georgia Engineering Foundation.
